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The following House Files were introduced:

Joy, Kiel and Keeler introduced:

H. F. No. 5332, A bill for an act relating to capital investment; appropriating money for flood hazard mitigation in the city of Moorhead, Clay County, and Wilkin County; authorizing the sale and issuance of state bonds.

The bill was read for the first time and referred to the Committee on Capital Investment.

Norris introduced:

H. F. No. 5333, A bill for an act relating to taxation; sales and use; modifying sales price for the tax on motor vehicle leases for certain leases; amending Minnesota Statutes 2022, section 297A.815, subdivision 1, by adding a subdivision.

The bill was read for the first time and referred to the Committee on Taxes.

Schultz, Petersburg, Scott and Torkelson introduced:

H. F. No. 5334, A bill for an act relating to transportation; requiring a legislative report on trunk highway project cultural resources expenditures; appropriating money.
