Dear Chair Anderson,

On January 18, 2018, the Department of Administration sent a letter to you and others reporting on Capitol events and fees collected from the effective date of the statute to the due date of the report. This letter is in response to your request for supplementary data related to events held at the Capitol from July 1, 2017 through December 31, 2017.

Per your request, Attachment 1 is a list of events held in the Capitol for which no fees were assessed or collected. Attachment 2 is a list of events held in the Capitol that are being assessed fees and the operating costs associated with those events. The only fees that have been collected are the deposits required to reserve the space. Operating costs incurred for events subject to fees are not tracked by individual event, but rather for fee-based work as a whole.

In addition, please note that the State Capitol Grand Opening was a unique, official event that was not subject to fees. That event was overseen by the State Capitol Preservation Commission with the expectation that the costs for the event be reimbursed from privately raised funds under explicit fundraising authority established in be M.S. 15B.32, subd. 6(a)(8).

Costs associated with general operations of the State Capitol during normal business hours, including extended hours during regular or special legislative sessions or other governmental uses of the building, are funded from tenant lease revenues and the inlieu of rent appropriation. Operating costs for these events is estimated to be \$67,000. The authority to collect fees for certain uses of the State Capitol under Minn. Stats. 16B.2405 first became effective July 1, 2017.
