2014 Survey Results

Last session Governor Dayton pushed through the largest tax and fee increases in Minnesota's history at more than \$2 billion. Was this a good decision?

Yes - 11% No - 89%

Do you believe our state's future economic condition will improve now that all Minnesotans are paying more to state government?

Yes - 13% No - 87%

Last year, Governor Dayton led the effort to create MnSURE, Minnesota's version of Obamacare. This new scheme has made health insurance more expensive for residents by requiring a more generous benefit package and limiting options. Do you support MnSURE/Obamacare?

Yes - 16% No - 84%

Governor Dayton and the Democratic majority approved a \$90 million office building for 44 senators and staff. The new office building includes a fitness center and window offices at the cost of \$3.3 million per legislator. Was this a good decision?

Yes - 5% No - 95%

Governor Dayton and the Minnesota Legislature voted to tax your water and electric bill during the 2013 legislative session. Was this a good decision?

Yes - 6% No - 94%

Governor Dayton and the Minnesota Legislature passed legislation (which is currently being challenged in court) requiring self-employed, independent people running home-based child care to become members of the union. Was this a good decision?

Yes - 3% No - 97%

Should Minnesota liquor stores be allowed to operate on Sundays?

Yes - 58% No - 42%

Do you support Minnesota becoming the 11th state to pass beverage container deposit legislation, which would require you to pay 10 cents more per container at the point of sale, but would return that amount when you bring in the used bottles or cans to a collections center?

Yes - 33% No - 77%

In an effort to limit the spread of Asian Carp in Minnesota, would you support closing the Upper St. Anthony Lock and Dam in Minneapolis to all boat traffic if the state does not erect an effective barrier elsewhere on the Mississippi River?

Yes - 72% No - 28%
