Bill Summary

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Subject: Repeal of Obsolete Highway and Vehicle Laws

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Repeals the following statutes:

Minnesota Statutes, section 167.45, providing that the costs of operating and maintaining the transportation building must be paid from the trunk highway fund

Minnesota Statutes, section 169.045, duplicating a provision found elsewhere in law (Minn. Stat. § 169.522, subd. 1) requiring motorized golf carts authorized to use streets and highways to bear a slow-moving vehicle emblem.

Minnesota Statutes, section 169.11, requiring a driver's license revocation for criminal negligence in operation of a motor vehicle resulting in death

Minnesota Statutes, section 169.78, authorizing municipal motor vehicle inspection stations

Minnesota Statutes, section 169.835, governing addition of routes to now-abolished federal-aid highway systems
