**Subject:** Registration for Medical Response Units

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## Overview

This bill creates a system of registration for medical response units and prescribes qualifications for registration and renewal.

## Section

- Medical response unit registration. Creates new § 144E.275. Creates a system of registration and registration renewal for medical response units.
  - **Subd. 1. Registration.** Allows the board to register a medical response unit.
  - **Subd. 2. Qualifications.** Sets qualifications that a medical response unit must meet in order to be registered. To be registered, a medical response unit must:
    - (1) submit an application prescribed by the board;
    - (2) submit a letter from the appropriate municipality, township, or county governing body recognizing the medical response unit as the unit in its geographical area designated to respond to a medical emergency;
    - (3) be routinely dispatched to the scene of a medical emergency by a public safety answering point or ambulance service;
    - (4) have a medical director; and
    - (5) be staffed by at least one first responder or one emergency medical technician, as appropriate to the level of care given.
  - **Subd. 3. Expiration.** Requires that the medical response unit registration expire two years from the date it is issued.
  - **Subd. 4. Renewal.** Allows the board to renew the medical response unit registration if the medical response unit (1) submits, before the expiration date, a completed renewal application form; (2) complies with the qualification requirements in subdivision 2, clauses (2) to (5); and (3) provides any other information that the board requests.

**Subd. 5. Definition.** Defines medical response unit.
