1	Occupational health and safety. Amends a statement of legislative findings dealing with
	workplace safety. Strikes reference to a health department role in development of an
	occupational health and safety plan.
2	Advisory council. Amends the statute on the occupational safety and heath advisory council.
	Eliminates the commissioner of health from membership on the council.
3	OSHA citations. Requires posting citations issued by the commissioner at or near where a
	violation occurred for 20 days. Current law requires posting for 15 days.
4	Fine for serious violation. Provides that if a serious violation of a standard, rule, or order
	causes or contributes to an employee's death, the fine is up to \$25,000.
5	Provides that in other circumstances, if a violation by an employer with fewer than 50
	employers (1) is connected with an employee death, and (2) is not willful or repeated, the
	fine is an initial \$5,000 and an additional \$5,000 for each of the following four years.
