Overview

H.F. 1109 applies to contracts between school boards and non-teaching employees and makes school board authority to contract or subcontract for services an inherent managerial right, unless that power is specifically prohibited by collective bargaining agreements with all units of affected employees. Allows either party to declare an impasse after 45 days of mediation, at which point the current collective bargaining agreement expires.

Allows either party to declare an impasse after 45 days of mediation, at which point the current collective bargaining agreement expires. Makes this section effective for contracts negotiated and entered into on or after July 1, 2003, and contracts beginning negotiation, but not entered into, before July 1, 2003.
