Provides that an application for a driver's license, learner's permit, or Minnesota ID card by an applicant under age 26 constitutes consent to registration with selective service. Requires the department of public safety to forward to the selective service system personal information on such applicants. Provides that if the applicant is under 18 and the license or ID card will expire after the 18th birthday, the department must forward the information when the applicant reaches 18.
