Provides that the definition of "commercial driver training school" includes business enterprises conducted by an elected or appointed authority of a state or local government if a fee is charged.

Repeals the law that grants exemptions from the law requiring that commercial driver training schools be licensed by the Department of Public Safety. These exemptions include driver education lessons given at no charge, employer-provided driver training for employees, home-school driver training, and high school and college courses.

Repeals the law that allows a certified high school driver training instructor to give instruction for a fee to persons over age 18 without obtaining a driver training school license, if there is no private commercial driver training school within 10 miles of the municipality where the instruction is given, and there is no adult driver training program in the schools of the district where the trainee resides.
