Home-processed and home-canned fruits and vegetables. Adds another type of product to those currently excluded from requirements that a seller obtain a state license before selling canned food products to the public. This exclusion would exempt a person who home-cans pickles, vegetables, or fruits and sells them at a community or social event, a farmers' market, a roadside stand, or some other venue. The exemption applies only to a person who receives less than \$5,000 per year from the sale of these products. Also, the bill requires specific labeling indicating who canned the product and the date of canning.
