Provides that if a vehicle has been left at a vehicle repair or service facility, it may be impounded and towed five business days after the facility notifies the owner by certified mail that the vehicle will be removed. Requires notification to identify the vehicle by registration number, VIN number, make, model, and color. Exempts the owner or agent of the owner of a service or repair facility from civil liability to the owner resulting from removal of the vehicle by a towing service. Requires vehicles so removed to be disposed of in the same manner as other unauthorized vehicles.
