Overview

This bill authorizes the sale of \$750,000 in state general obligation bonds in order to provide a grant to the city of Gaylord for the design and construction of a multicultural and lifelong learning center.

Section

1 Gaylord multicultural and life long learning center.

Subdivision 1. Appropriation. Appropriates \$750,000 from the state bond proceeds fund to the commissioner of education for a grant to the city of Gaylord (located in Sibley County) for design and construction of a multicultural and lifelong learning center. Requires the appropriation to be matched by an equal amount from nonstate sources.

Subd. 2. Bond Sale. Authorizes the commissioner of finance to sell and issue up to \$750,000 of general obligation bonds in order to fund the appropriation to the city of Gaylord.

2 Effective date. Makes section 1 effective the day following final enactment.
