- 1** **Trapping license.** Adds a new trapping license fee for nonresidents of \$73.
- 2** **Nonresidents: raccoon, bobcat, fox, coyote, Canada lynx.** Clarifies that a nonresident, possessing a small game license, must also have a separate license to take raccoon, bobcat, fox, coyote, or Canada lynx by firearm.
- 3** **Nonresidents; trapping small game.** States that, with the proper licenses, a nonresident only may trap small game on land owned by the person.
- 4** **Tending snares.** Requires a snare to be tended at least once every third calendar day.
- 5** **Repealer.** Repeals a state rule that required snares holding animals underwater to be tended every calendar day.
