This bonding proposal is for the first phase of a regional public safety training center in Rochester. It is for a live burn training simulator.

According to the Governor's project narrative, the facility's primary purpose is to "enable experienced fire fighter trainers ... to provide a safe, controlled and consistently available environment for area fire fighters. The live burn facility will be constructed to simulate a 4-story high-rise building, a 2-story commercial building and a single story residential structure using building materials designed to withstand the repeated high temperatures associated with training fires."
