## Overview

In 1991, the Legislature authorized each school district to levy up to \$300,000 for disability access projects. The levy authority extended for eight years, once a district started levying for projects. The levy proceeds are reserved until they are spent on the qualifying projects. Some school districts have levied for intended projects but have not yet spent all of the money on those projects. Under current law, if the project is finally abandoned, the unused levy money is returned to the taxpayers through a levy adjustment in a subsequent year.

This bill authorizes the MACCRAY School District (the name for the consolidated districts of Maynard, Clara City, and Raymond) to transfer these funds to the district's undesignated general fund balance.

## Section

1 Fund transfer; MACCRAY. Authorizes Independent School District No. 2180, MACCRAY, to transfer up to \$230,000 from its disabled access reserved in the capital account to the undesignated general fund balance. Requires the school district to demonstrate to the commissioner's satisfaction that the district's school buildings are accessible to students or staff with disabilities.
