- Licensing of providers. Current law subjects a local unit of government to tort liability if it had actual knowledge that a licensed day care provider failed to meet licensing standards that resulted in a dangerous condition or failed to meet licensing requirements related to swimming pools. The bill eliminates these forms of liability.
- 2 **Authorization for nonlicensed providers.** Immunizes local governments against liability for claims arising from payment to a legal non-licensed family child care provider.
- 3 **Effective date.** Immediate.
