Provides that 90 percent of all revenue from the surcharge on motorcycle endorsements on driver's licenses in excess of \$750,000 will go to the motorcycle safety fund rather than the trunk highway fund. The remaining ten percent will continue to go to the general fund. The first \$750,000 in revenue will continue to go to the motorcycle safety fund.

(The surcharge on motorcycle endorsements is \$11 on the first license and \$7 on renewals.)
