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Overview

This bill changes the name of the Greater Minnesota Redevelopment Account to the Minnesota Development Account, and makes grants from the account available within the seven-county metropolitan area. The bill also provides bond fund appropriations to the account.

1	Account designations amended. Changes name of greater Minnesota redevelopment accounts to Minnesota development accounts.
2	Definition amended. Amends the definition of a development authority to eliminate the requirement that such an entity be located outside the seven-county metropolitan area. (A development authority is an entity entitled to apply for grants from the redevelopment accounts)
3	Defined term modified. Changes a defined term from "redevelopment" to "development."

4	Reference eliminated. Eliminates reference to greater Minnesota in list of criteria for use of
	redevelopment accounts.
5	Conforming changes. Makes conforming changes to account names and eliminates
	reference to greater Minnesota.
6	Priority for TIF districts eliminated. Eliminates priority for proposals contributing tax
	increment financing towards a project.

9 Conforming changes.

- **10 Appropriation.** Appropriates \$10 million for the Minnesota development account and requires that the money be divided equally between redevelopment and new development. Appropriates \$15 million to the development account for eligible projects in the biotechnology and health science zone.
- **Bond sale.** Authorizes the sale of state bonds to provide the money appropriated in section 10.
- **12 Effective date.** Effective the day following final enactment.
