Allows the city of Proctor to use up to 10 percent the revenues from its local lodging tax, imposed under general law, for preservation of a caboose, locomotive, and F-101F aircraft. The general law requires that a local government use 95 percent of revenues from the authorized local lodging tax for tourism promotion.
