## Bill Summary

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**Version:** First Engrossment

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**Subject:** CriMNet; Policy and Technical Changes Bill

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### Overview

This is a housekeeping bill that makes various minor technical and policy changes relating to CriMNet.

#### Section

- 1** **Program manager; project management techniques.** Provides that the CriMNet program manager serves at the pleasure of the policy group in the unclassified service. Adds "education and training" to the project management techniques that must be utilized on each CriMNet project.
- 2** **Task force.** Clarifies that the CriMNet task force monitors, reviews, and reports to the policy group on CriMNet-related projects and provides oversight for ongoing operations. Removes the director of the Office of Strategic and Long Range Planning from the task force. Also deletes references to the CriMNet annual report, which is given its own subdivision (see section 3).
- 3** **Report.** Places the CriMNet annual report in its own subdivision. In addition to recommending yearly legislative changes and appropriations, the report must also address:
  - the status of current integration efforts and projects;
  - a summary of the activities of the policy group and task force; and
  - the number and description of project objectives achieved during the prior year.

**4**      **Repealer.** Repeals two subdivisions relating to recommendations the policy group was required to make ten years ago.
