Overview

This bill imposes restrictions on issuance of a provisional driver's license (driver's license issued to a person under age 18) and instruction (learner's) permit.

Section

1 Reinstatement of provisional license. Prohibits issuance of a provisional or regular driver's license to a person whose provisional license was revoked for a juvenile conviction for alcohol-related driving offense or crash-related moving violation, until the person reaches age 18 and:

- completes a driver education course
- completes an additional three months experience in driving
- passes the written examination for a driver's license
- complies with all other reinstatement laws
- 2 Issuance of instruction permit. Prohibits issuance of an instruction (learner's) permit to a person under age 18 if the person has ever been convicted of a DWI-related offense, or a crash-related moving violation.

Section

- **3 Issuance of provisional license.** Prohibits issuance of a provisional driver's license to a person who has ever incurred a DWI-related violation or a crash-related moving violation, and at the time of conviction did not have an instruction permit.
- **4 Effective date.** Makes all sections effective immediately.
