## **Overview**

This bill involves homeowner's insurance for homes in which a home day care business is operated.

## **Section**

- 1 Day care services coverage.
  - **Subd. 1. No coverage.** No change from current law, which says that claims arising out of a home day care businesses are not covered under homeowner's insurance, unless the insurer has specifically agreed to cover them.
  - **Subd. 2. Prohibited underwriting practices.** Prohibits insurers from refusing to issue or renew homeowner's insurance solely because the homeowner operates a home day care business caring for five or fewer children.
- **Effective date.** Makes section 1 effective January 1, 2005, and apply to coverage issued or renewed on or after that date.
