Subject:	DNR notice of vacation of town road, city street, or plat		
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Section

1	Hearing; notice (town roads). Requires the petitioners to notify the commissioner of
	natural resources that they petitioned the town board to vacate a road that terminates at,
	abuts, or, under this bill, is adjacent to any public water, at least 60 days before the hearing,
	increased from 30 days. At least 15 days before the hearing, the commissioner's
	representative must evaluate: (1) the public benefits of the proposed road vacation; (2) the
	present and potential use of the land for public water access; and (3) the impact of a
	vacation on conservation of natural resources. After the evaluation, the commissioner's
	representative must notify the town board or its designee of the results.
2	Vacation of streets (statutory cities). Requires the city council to notify the commissioner
	of natural resources of a proposal to vacate a street, alley, or public way that terminates at,
	abuts, or, under this bill, is adjacent to any public water, least 60 days before the hearing,
	increased from 30 days. At least 15 days before the hearing, the commissioner's
	representative must evaluate: (1) the public benefits of the proposed road vacation; (2) the
	present and potential use of the land for public water access; and (3) the impact of a
	vacation on conservation of natural resources. After the evaluation, the commissioner's
	representative must notify the city council or its designee of the results.
3	Vacation (of plats). Requires notice to the commissioner of natural resources of a proposal
	to vacate a plat if part of the vacation is a road or street that terminates at, abuts or, under
	this bill, is adjacent to any public water, at least 60 days before the hearing, increased from
	30 days. Provides that notice creates a right for the commissioner to intervene. Under
	current law, there is no right to intervene.
