Overview

This bill supplements an existing statutory section governing students' access to drugs and medicine in school. It proposes to allow secondary students to possess and properly use nonprescription pain relief if the student's parent or guardian authorizes the student's access to the medicine.

Section

Possession and use of nonprescription pain relievers by secondary students. Allows secondary students to possess and properly use nonprescription pain relief if the student's parent or guardian provides the school district with annual written authorization. Allows the school district to revoke the authorization of a student it determines is abusing that authorization.
