This bill appropriates an unspecified amount from the general fund to the Minnesota Historical Society for the operation of seven historical sites in 2005 and 2006:

- Kelley Farm;
- Hill House;
- Lower Sioux Agency;
- Fort Ridgely;
- Historic Forestville;
- the Forest History Center; and
- the Comstock House

The bill provides for a one-time appropriation, not to be added to the Historical Society's base. The bill would be effective the day following final enactment.
