### Section

- 1**      **Solicitation process not required.** Provides that state agencies need not follow the usual solicitation process when acquiring goods and services from day training and habilitation services (This adds to an existing list of circumstances in which state agencies need not follow the usual solicitation process).
- 2**      **Joint powers agreement.** Adds rehabilitation facilities, extended employment providers, and day training and habilitation services to the definition of "government unit" for purposes of the law allowing for joint powers agreements among government units.
