Allows a licensed peace officer with a class D driver's license to operate any vehicle or combination of vehicles while on duty.

Directs the Department of Public Safety to determine if federal commercial driver's license laws and regulations would be violated by allowing peace officers to move commercial vehicles to prevent a safety hazard. If the department determines that this authorization would violate federal law or rule, it would be required to seek a federal waiver.
