Overview

This bill authorizes, but does not require, the commissioner of public safety to waive, for a military veteran, the requirement to take a *road test* to obtain a Minnesota driver's license permitting the person to drive certain motor vehicles in the state, if the person is currently, or within the past year has been, validly licensed by any branch of the United States Armed Forces to drive the same class or classes of motor vehicle.

The bill would *not* authorize the commissioner to exempt the veteran from the requirement to take the *written exam* for any license.
