Overview

Prior to 2003, the commissioner had the authority to establish maximum half-day child care reimbursement rates for each type of care. In 2003, half-day child care reimbursement rates were eliminated. This bill restores the authority of the commissioner to establish maximum rates for child care assistance provided on a half-day basis.

Section

- 1 Subsidy restrictions.** Amends § 119B.13, subd. 1. Includes care provided on a half-day basis in the list of increments of time for which the commissioner must establish a maximum rate for each type of care.
