Overview

This bill increases the maximum per diem for watershed district managers from \$55 to \$75, and authorizes watershed district staff and agents to enter onto land, in addition to the managers.

Section

- 1 Compensation.** Increases maximum compensation for watershed district managers from \$55/day to \$75/day.
- 2 Entry on lands.** Allows watershed district staff, or agents (e.g., surveyors, engineers) with written authorization on his or her person from the watershed district, to enter onto private land for surveys and investigations related to watershed district purposes. Under current law, only the managers are allowed to do so.
