- 1 **Definition of recreational vehicle combination.** Amends the definition of "recreational vehicle combination" to allow the third vehicle in such a combination to be a trailer carrying equestrian equipment and supplies.
- 2 **Recreational vehicle combinations.** Amends the law regulating recreational vehicle combinations to reflect the change made in section 0.
- 3 **Agricultural exemption from relevant evidence law.** Amends the provision exempting the first haul of farm and forest products from the relevant evidence law (allowing weight tickets to be used as evidence of overweight) by making technical corrections, and by specifying that forest products include wood chips.
- 4 **Forest product weight limits.** Amends the 2004 law that allows vehicles hauling forest products to exceed weight limits, by:
 - imposing a 20,000 pound limit on single axles of such vehicles
 - specifying that such vehicles may exceed legal axle weights in the gross weight schedule by up to 12.5 percent, or 22.5 percent during the period when winter weight allowances are in effect
- 5 **Annual permits.** Allows annual oversize and overweight permits for hauling manufactured storage buildings.
- 6 **Repealer.** Repeals obsolete motor carrier rules that refer to motor carrier regulation that is no longer in effect.
