Overview

This bill prohibits several acts related to tampering with farm tractor clock-hour meters. Civil penalties and a private right to action are prescribed.

Section

1 2	Definitions. Defines "farm tractor" and "person." Clock-hour meters; prohibited acts. Prohibits:			
	• tampering with clock-hour meters with the intent to defraud;			
	• operating a tractor with a disconnected or nonfunctional clock-hour meter with intent to defraud;			
	• advertising, selling, using, or installing a clock-hour meter tampering device;			
	• selling or offering for sale a farm tractor with knowledge that the hours registered have been altered to reflect fewer hours than the tractor has actually been in operation; and			
	• conspiring with another person to commit any of these acts.			

Penalty; right of action. Authorizes civil penalties. The injured party may recover actual 3 damages, as well as costs and disbursements including reasonable attorney fees. A court

may increase damages above this amount but may not exceed 3x the actual damages or \$1,500, whichever is greater.
