Overview

This bill allows for the commissioner of human services to make a licensing exception to replace a 32-bed intermediate care facility in Brooklyn Park with four six-bed facilities and appropriates an unspecified amount for the new facilities.

Section

2

1 Licensing exception. Creates § 252.295. Paragraph (a) allows the commissioner to license four six-bed, level B intermediate care facilities for persons with developmental disabilities to replace a 32-bed facility in Brooklyn Park. Requires the new facilities to be located in Hennepin County.

Paragraph (b) establishes payment rates for the four new facilities and for the facility that is being replaced.

Paragraph (c) makes certain payment rates under paragraph (b) effective until state rate-setting adjustments occur in 2009 or until October 1, 2009, whichever occurs first.
Appropriation. Appropriates an unspecified amount from the general fund to the commissioner of human services for the 2008-09 biennium for the purposes of section 1.
