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Subject: Limiting Child Care Assistance Absent Days

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Overview

This bill limits the number of absent days for which child care providers may be reimbursed under the child care assistance programs.

Section

- 1 Subsidy restrictions.** Amends § 119B.13, subd. 1. Removes language requiring the commissioner to evaluate market practices for payment of absent days and establish policies for payment of absent days that reflect current market practice. Makes technical changes.
- 2 Absent days.** Amends § 119B.13, by adding subd. 7. Prohibits child care providers from being reimbursed for more than a specified number of absent days, unless the child has a documented medical condition that causes more frequent absences. Requires documentation to be on the forms and submitted according to the timelines established by the commissioner. Makes this section effective July 1, 2005.
