Overview

Provides that a municipality may construct street or road improvements outside its jurisdiction with the consent of the affected township, or with the county if the township is unorganized. Effective for street and road improvements first ordered after August 1, 2005.

Section

1 Street or road improvements outside municipal boundaries. Provides that a municipality may construct street or road improvements outside its jurisdiction with the consent of the affected township, or with the county if the property is located in unorganized territory.

When property is brought within the corporate limits of the municipality, the municipality may subsequently reimburse itself for all or a portion of the cost of the improvement that was paid for with municipal funds, by levying an assessment upon any property abutting the improvement, but not previously assessed for the improvement. No assessment may be levied unless the property to be assessed was given proper notice and hearing of the improvements as provided under section 429.031 (i.e. the standard notice and hearing requirements for the preliminary plans for special assessments), at the time the improvement was ordered, and subsequently upon notice and hearing when the improvement was initially made.

Effective for street and road improvements first ordered after August 1, 2005.
