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Subject: Increased city aid base for Minneapolis

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Overview

City LGA consists of two parts: formula aid that is determined by a city's "need" and "ability to raise revenue," and city aid base or "grandfathered aid" which is a permanent amount that is paid to certain cities that meet specified criteria. This bill would provide an additional \$12 million in city aid base to the city of Minneapolis to use for increased police and prosecutor services.

Section

- City aid base. Provides for a permanent increase in the LGA city aid base of \$12 million annually, beginning with aids payable in 2006, for a city with a 2003 population of 100,000 and a net tax capacity tax rate for levies payable in 2004 of at least 50 percent. The city of Minneapolis is the only city that qualifies.
- 2 Use of revenues. Requires that the extra LGA received under section 0be used to increase spending on police services and prosecutors in the city attorney's office, above the level in calendar year 2005.
- 3 **Cities (appropriation cap).** Increases the limit on the amount that may be paid annually for city LGA by \$12 million to \$449,052,000. Effective for aids payable in 2006 and thereafter.
