### Overview

This bill reduces the number of hours an MFIP participant must work in unsubsidized employment in order for a postsecondary education or training program to be approved in an employment plan.

#### Section

- 1 Approval of postsecondary education and training.** Amends § 256J.53, subd. 2. Reduces the number of hours per week (from 20 hours to 10 hours) an MFIP participant must work in unsubsidized employment in order for a postsecondary education or training program to be an approved activity in an employment plan.
