Overview

This bill appropriates money from the general fund to the commissioner of employment and economic development for three youth programs: Learn to Earn; the Minnesota Youth Program; and Youthbuild.

Section

- 1 Learn to earn.** Appropriates \$183,000 in each fiscal year of the biennium from the general fund to the commissioner for grants to the learn to earn summer youth employment program. Makes grants under this section available until spent.
- 2 Minnesota youth program.** Appropriates \$4,190,000 in each fiscal year of the biennium from the general fund to the commissioner for the Minnesota Youth Program.
- 3 Youthbuild.** Appropriates \$757,000 in each fiscal year of the biennium from the general fund to the commissioner for the Youthbuild program.
