Overview

This bill requires the commissioner of health to provide methamphetamine education materials and requires that the commissioner of corrections and sheriffs provide these education materials to methamphetamine offenders in county jails and prisons.

Section

- 1** **Methamphetamine offender education materials.** Adds § 144.0506. Requires the commissioner of health to provide education materials to be used by sheriffs and the commissioner of corrections in educating county jail and prison inmates on the health hazards of methamphetamine use and manufacture.
 - 2** **Methamphetamine education; prisons.** Adds § 243.30. Requires the commissioner of corrections to provide methamphetamine education materials to new inmates.
 - 3** **Methamphetamine education; jails.** Adds § 387.115. Requires that the sheriff provide everyone incarcerated in the county jail with education materials on the hazards of methamphetamine use and manufacture. States that the commissioner of corrections shall develop rules to implement this requirement.
- Effective date.** States that this section is effective July 1, 2006.
