Overview

This bill directs the commissioner of human services to collect data and develop rules regarding best practices for post-adoption searches.

Section

- **Data and rules.** Adds § 259.88.
 - **Subd. 1. Required data; minimum standards for post-adoption search services.** Directs the commissioner of human services to collect data from all adoption agencies for six months so that benchmarks can be established regarding reasonable efforts in conducting post-adoption searches.
 - **Subd. 2. Rules.** Directs the commissioner of human services, in consultation with the commissioner of health, to develop best practice guidelines for post-adoption searches.
- **Effective date.** Section 1 is effective the day following final enactment.
