Overview

The 2005 school funding bill contained a best practices grant of \$100,000 per year for the quantum opportunities program (see Laws 2005, chapter 5, article 2, section 84, subdivision 21, for details). This bill requests a grant of \$750,000 per year to the Summit Academy Opportunities Industrialization Center (OIC) for its quantum opportunities program.

Section

- 1 Appropriation.** Appropriates \$750,000 per year in fiscal years 2006 and 2007 from the general fund to the Department of Education for a grant to the Summit Academy OIC. Requires the Department of Education to report to the legislature by December 15, 2007 on the effectiveness of the quantum opportunities program in closing the achievement gap.
