Overview

This bill addresses law enforcement data issues.

Section

- 1** **Notice of multiple law enforcement operations conflicts.** Authorizes the Department of Public Safety to employ a secure subscription service designed to notify law enforcement agencies of conflicts where multiple law enforcement operations may be occurring on the same subject or vehicle, or near the same location. System data is classified as criminal investigative data under the Data Practices Act.
- 2** **Definitions.** Adds the Fugitive Apprehension Unit to the list of law enforcement agencies that have access to CIBRS - the Comprehensive Incident-Based Reporting System. CIBRS is a statewide system containing data from law enforcement agencies.
