Overview

This bill requires EMT training programs maintain an average yearly pass rate on the state EMT certification examination.

Section

- 1** **Approval required.** Amends §144E.285, subdivision 1. Adds a requirement that each EMT training program maintain an average yearly pass rate on the state EMT certification examination equal to the national average pass rate. The pass rate is based on individuals who pass the examination on the first attempt. Provides that the board shall place a program on probation and on a performance improvement plan until the program meets the pass rate standard. Allows the board to take disciplinary action against a program if it fails to meet the pass rate standard after two years.
