Overview

This bill changes classification of data and notice requirements regarding youth who have committed a misdemeanor theft crime and reside in a home where family child care is provided.

Section

- Classification of certain data. Amends § 245C.22, subd. 7. Provides that the set-aside of a disqualification or a variance to a license holder is not public data if the subject of the set-aside or variance is a household member who resides in the residence, is under age 18, and the set aside or variance is related only to a disqualification for a misdemeanor theft crime as defined in section 609.52.
- Notification of set-aside or variance. Amends § 245C.301. Provides that notice regarding a set-aside or variance does not need to be given if the subject of the set-aside or variance is a household member who resides in the residence, is under age 18, and the set aside or variance is related only to a disqualification for a misdemeanor theft crime as defined in section 609.52.
