Overview

Allows cities or counties to issue limited wine and beer on-sale intoxicating liquor licenses to business establishments providing cooking or culinary classes.

Section

- 1 Culinary Classes; On-Sale License.
 - **Subd. 1. License Authorized.** Authorizes cities or counties to issue an on-sale license limited to wine or beer, for use as part of a culinary or cooking class.
 - **Subd. 2. Samples.** Allows the licensee to dispense samples to the public, for demonstration purposes.
 - **Subd. 3. Fee.** Allows issuing authorities to set fees for this section, subject to existing limits.
 - **Subd. 4. Application of Other Law.** Applies all existing laws, except those that conflict with this section, and except for the dram shop requirements.
- **Effective Date.** Section 1 is effective the day following final enactment.
