Overview

This bill creates mandatory conditional release periods for those convicted of child pornography offenses.

Section

- Conditional release term. Requires courts who sentence offenders to prison based on a conviction for using minors in sexual performances (617.246) to impose a five-year conditional release period to be served upon release from prison. The court must impose a 10-year conditional release term for those with previous sex offense convictions.
- **Conditional release term.** Requires courts who sentence offenders to prison based on a conviction for disseminating or possessing child pornography (617.247) to impose a five-year conditional release period to be served upon release from prison. The court must impose a 10-year conditional release term for those with previous sex offense convictions.
