Overview

This bill adds a new classification of special family day care home.

Section

- **1 Special family day care home.** Amends Minnesota Statutes 2005 Supplement, §245A.14, subdivision 4.
 - Adds as a classification of special family day care home a program in which the license holder is a not-for-profit agency that has at least two contracts with community employers or organizations to provide child care services.
 - The program must be located in a dwelling on a residential lot.
 - Allows a capacity variance to be granted for the program to exceed the capacity of 14 children by no more than five children during transition periods if:
 - Capacity is not exceeded for more than a total of four hours per day;
 - There is a one to seven staff-to-child ratio;
 - All employees receive at least 4 additional hours of training each year;
 - Square footage requirements are met;
 - The program complies with local zoning ordinances;

Section

- The program complies with applicable fire codes; and
- Age and capacity limitations based on square footage requirements and fire code inspection are printed on the license.
- 2 Effective date. Section 1 is effective the day following final enactment.
