Amends rider language included in the 2005 public safety funding provisions. The amendment permits counties, their designees, or courts to receive reimbursement for sex offender assessments. The change clarifies that not only counties are entitled to reimbursement from the \$350,000 appropriated to the commissioner of corrections for this purpose.
