Overview

A PELRA exemption allows school districts and other public schools to pay wages according the terms of an applicable contract, collective bargaining agreement or personnel policy instead of complying with the general requirement to make timely wage payments to employees. This bill proposes to allow nonpublic schools the same employee wage payment options currently afforded public schools under PELRA.

Section

1 Wages; how often paid. Exempts nonpublic schools from having to make timely payment of wages and instead allows nonpublic schools to pay make wage payments according the terms of an applicable contract, collective bargaining agreement or personnel policy.
