## Overview

This bill provides for interstate contracts for chemical health services.

## **Section**

- **1 Definitions.** Amends §245.50, subdivision 1. Adds chemical health treatment facility to the definition of "receiving agency." Adds chemical health to the services under this section.
- 2 Purpose and authority. Amends §245.50, subdivision 2. Adds facilities that provide chemical health services as facilities that are authorized to have interstate contracts to provide services to residents of a bordering state.
- **3 Special contracts; bordering states.** Amends §245.50, subdivision 5. Provides that an individual who is detained, committed, or placed on an involuntary basis under chapter 253B may be confined or treated in a bordering state pursuant to a contract under this section for chemical dependency services.
